

## Public Notice

The Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will consider public input on two proposed amendments to the **Transportation Improvement Program for the Eau Claire Urbanized Area 2018-2022 (TIP)**. This document includes a listing of state- and federally-funded transportation projects currently programmed for the 5-year period and was adopted on October 11, 2017.

The first proposed amendment will add, alter, or delete a total of nine (9) projects: Eau Claire Transit's purchase of two (2) new buses; the purchase of one (1) new van for the Chippewa Falls Shared Ride Taxi Program; funding for Western Dairyland's vehicle loan and mobility management programs; and two (2) highway safety projects – on USH 12 in Altoona, and at the intersection of STH 178 and CTH I in Chippewa Falls. The last four projects were reconsidered after the area's allocation of federal STBG-Urban funds were cut by WisDOT, resulting in the reduction in funding for two projects and removal of two scheduled road projects in the urbanized area.

The second proposed amendment pertains to the addition of language describing the targets for transit asset management and the coordination of the relevant data for planning purposes. The performance measures and targets are based on federal and state guidance and serve the goal of improving transportation in the Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Area.

This notice is also intended to provide the public with the opportunity to request a public hearing concerning said amendments to the 2018-2022 TIP, if circumstances warrant. Public notice of public participation activities and time established for public review of and comments on the TIP will satisfy the FTA grantees' Programs of Projects requirements.
