

Public Notice

The Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will consider public input on a proposed amendment to the **Transportation Improvement Program for the Eau Claire Urbanized Area 2018-2022 (TIP)**. This document includes a listing of state- and federally-funded transportation projects currently programmed for the 5-year period and was adopted on October 11, 2017.

The proposed amendment will remove one (1) project, Elm Street in the City of Chippewa Falls, and alter three (3) projects: Fairfax Street in the cities of Eau Claire and Altoona, Jeffers Road in the City of Eau Claire, CTH T in Eau Claire County. These projects are anticipating federal funding under the FAST Act, STBG-Urban program for construction in 2021. The resolution of approval will include language regarding the intention to restore all four projects to their originally allocated funding levels in the event that the MPO's STBG-Urban funding is made whole for the current funding cycle.

This notice is also intended to provide the public with the opportunity to request a public hearing concerning said amendment to the 2018-2022 TIP, if circumstances warrant. Public notice of public participation activities and time established for public review of and comments on the TIP will satisfy the FTA grantees' Programs of Projects requirements.
