

Public Notice

The Chippewa-Eau Claire Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will consider public input on two (2) proposed amendments to the **Transportation Improvement Program for the Eau Claire Urbanized Area 2018-2022 (TIP)**. This document includes a listing of state- and federally-funded transportation projects currently programmed for the 5-year period and was adopted on October 11, 2017.

Proposed “Amendment #8”, will add seven (7) highway projects and five (5) transit-related projects to the TIP. Highway projects include: signal and gate improvements at two rail crossings; and several WisDOT sponsored bridge or highway maintenance projects. The transit projects include federal capital and operating funding for the CILWW, including the purchase of a transit van, and the continuation of mobility management services and volunteer driver and voucher programs throughout the region; two (2) replacement buses for Eau Claire Transit; and one (1) replacement minivan for Chippewa Falls Shared Ride Taxi service.

Under a separate action, “Amendment #9”, the MPO will also be formally adopting the State’s Performance Measures Targets for Safety Performance, Pavement and Bridge Condition, Freight Movement and Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality, and Transit State of Good Repair and Transit Asset Management.

This notice is also intended to provide the public with the opportunity to request a public hearing concerning said amendment to the 2018-2022 TIP, if circumstances warrant. Public notice of public participation activities and time established for public review of and comments on the TIP will satisfy the FTA grantees’ Programs of Projects requirements.
